

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN COMPUTER-BASED INFORMATION SYSTEMS (MSIS)

ENTRY AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- (a) The following are eligible for admission into the Master of Science in Computer-Based Information Systems (MSc.CIS) programme:
 - (i) Holders of First Class or Upper Second Class Honours degrees in any discipline from recognized universities; or
 - (ii) Holders of other related qualifications from recognized universities, considered by the Academic Council as equivalent to a First Class or Upper Second Class degree in any discipline; or
 - (iii) Holders of Lower Second Class degrees plus Postgraduate Diplomas or Certificates; or
- (b) In addition to meeting the above admission criteria, applicants:
 - (i) Will normally have at least two year's working experience in a business or research environment; and
 - (ii) Will be required to attend and pass an oral interview and a graduate entrance examination (GEE).
 - (iii) Will be required to present two reference letters from academic referees.
- (c) Exemptions and Credit transfers are granted at the discretion of the Academic Council and will be no more than 50% of the total course loading.
