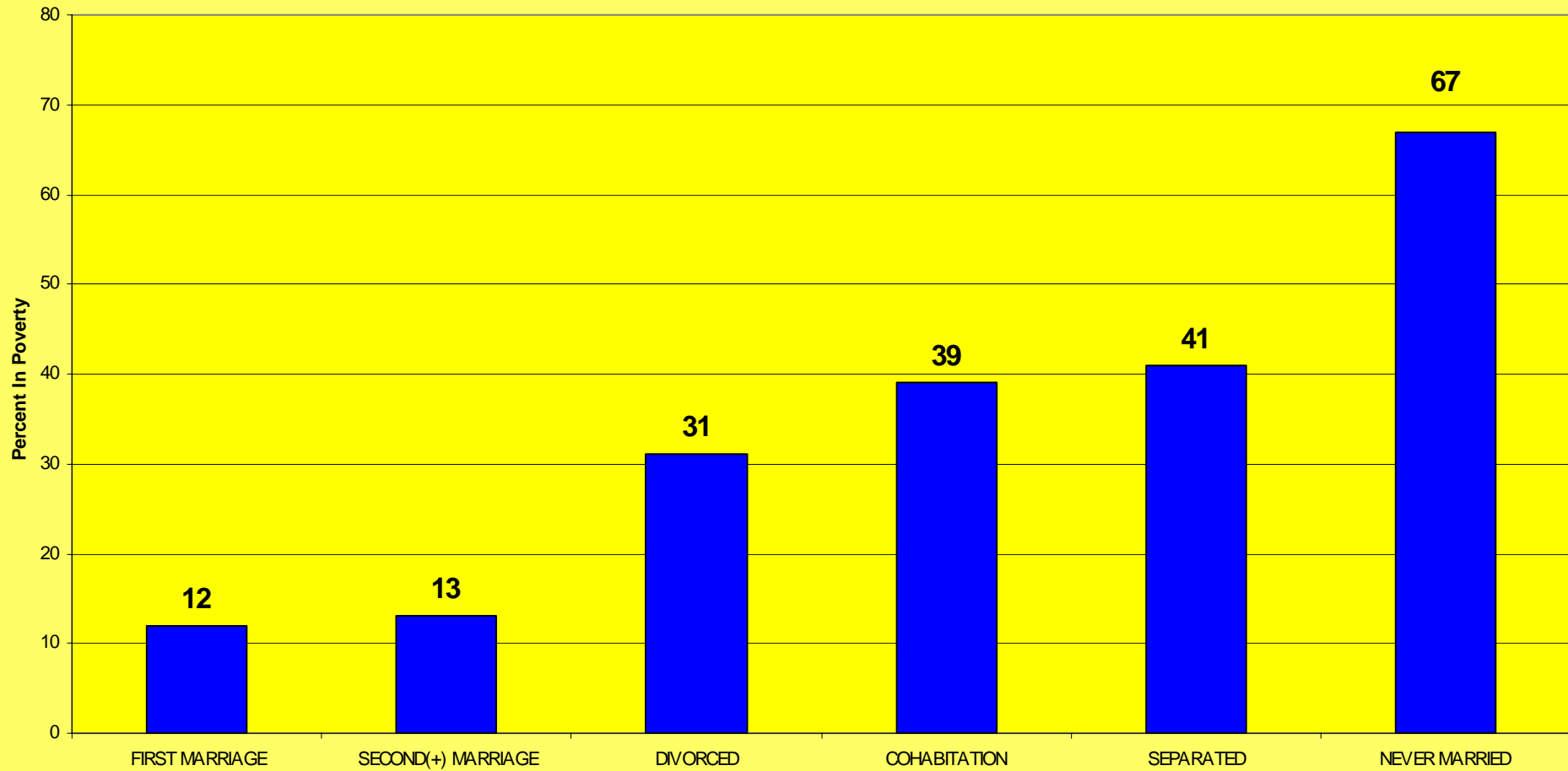

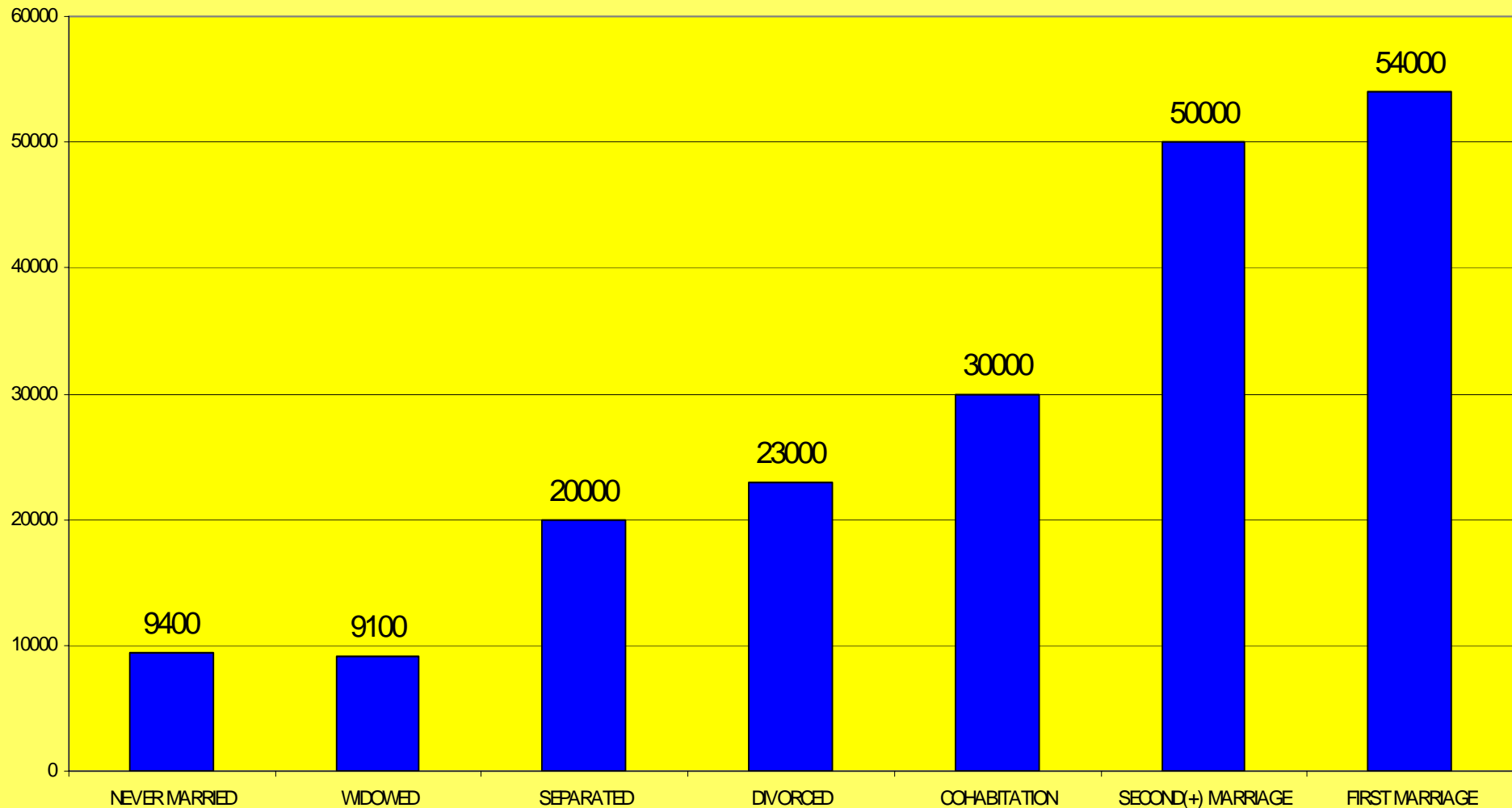

(Chart 1) Children in Poverty by Family Structure, 2000

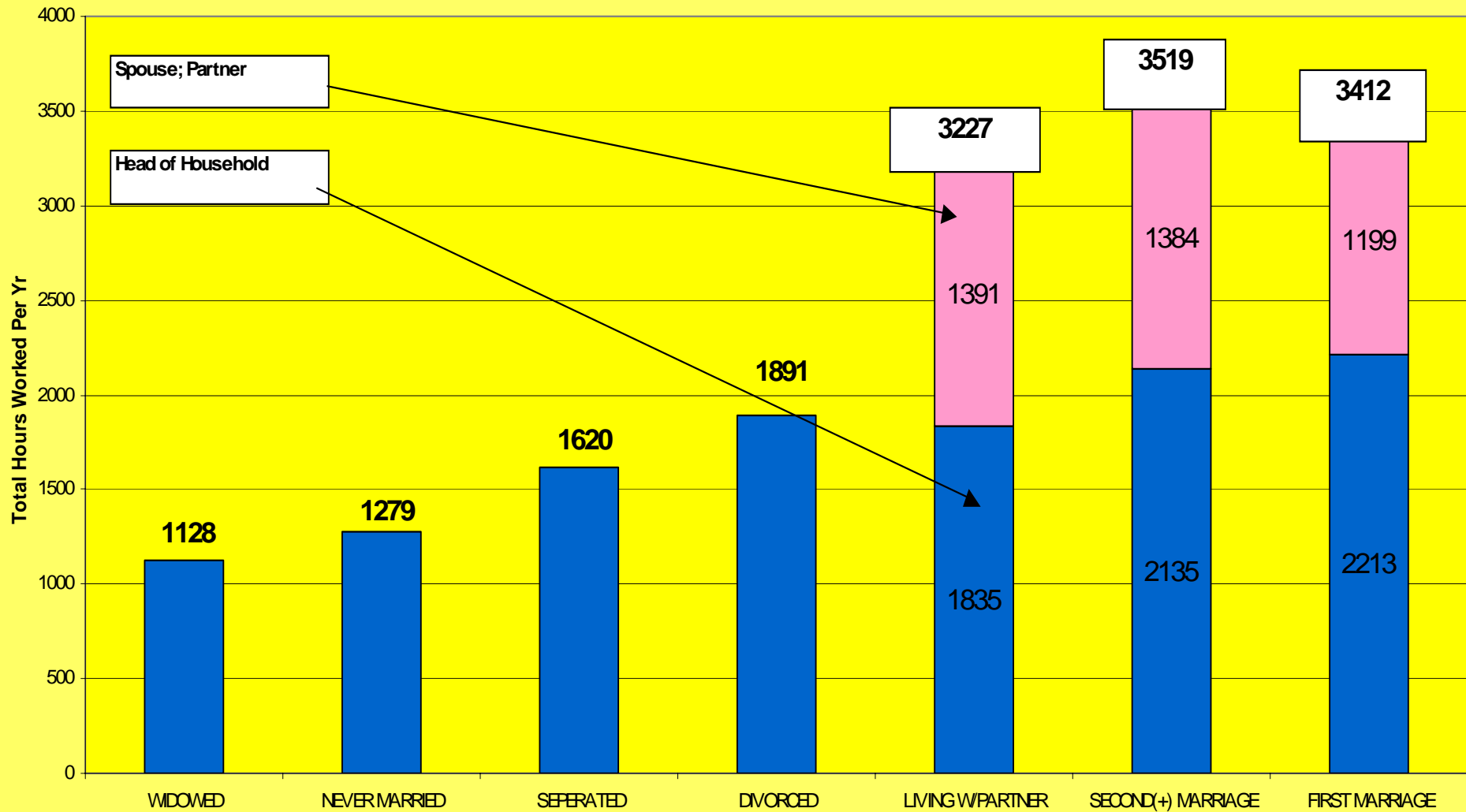

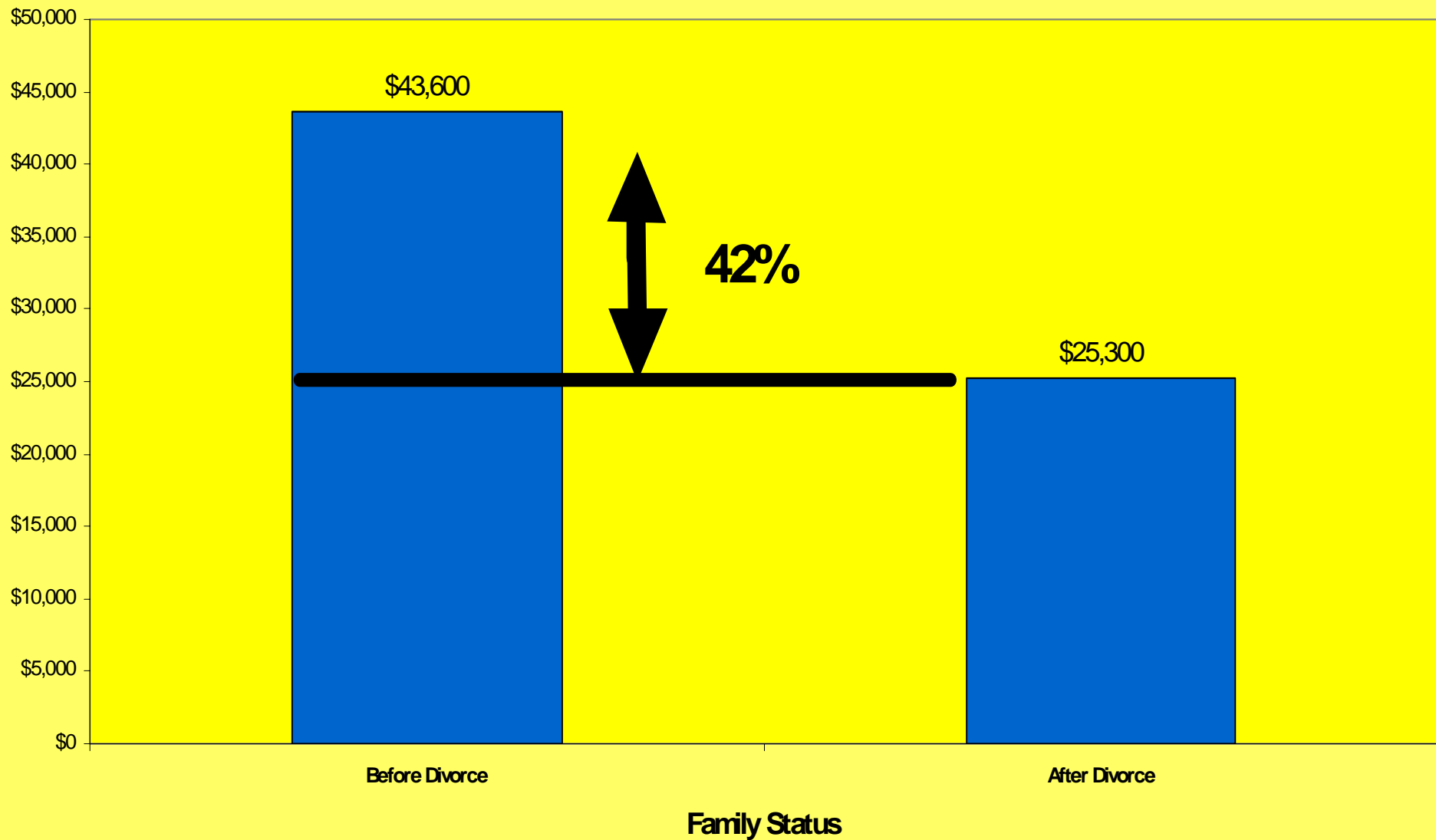
(Chart 2) Annual Income of Families with Children Under 18, by Family Structure, 2000



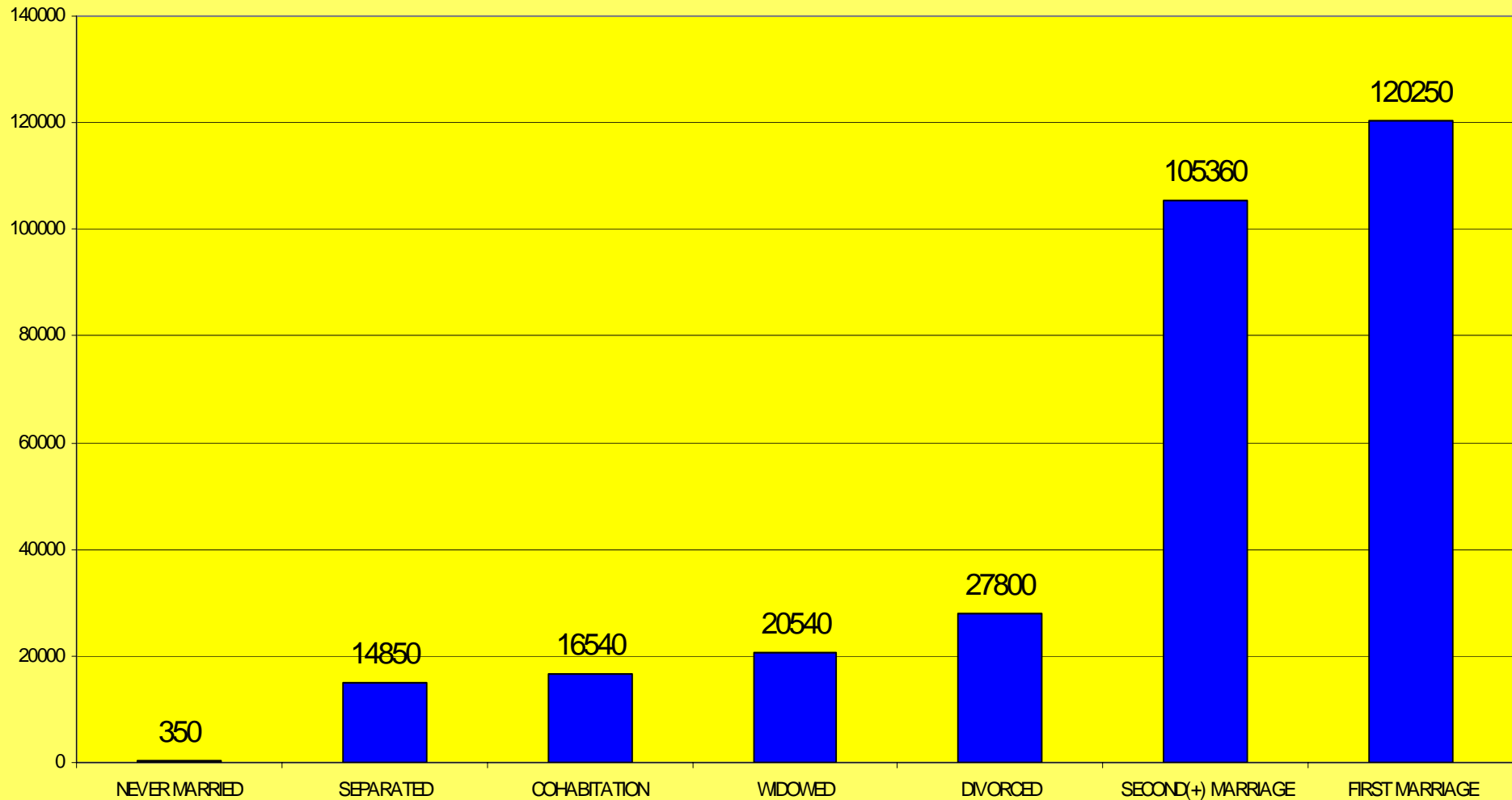
(Chart 3) Average Hours Worked Per Year in Families with Children, 2000



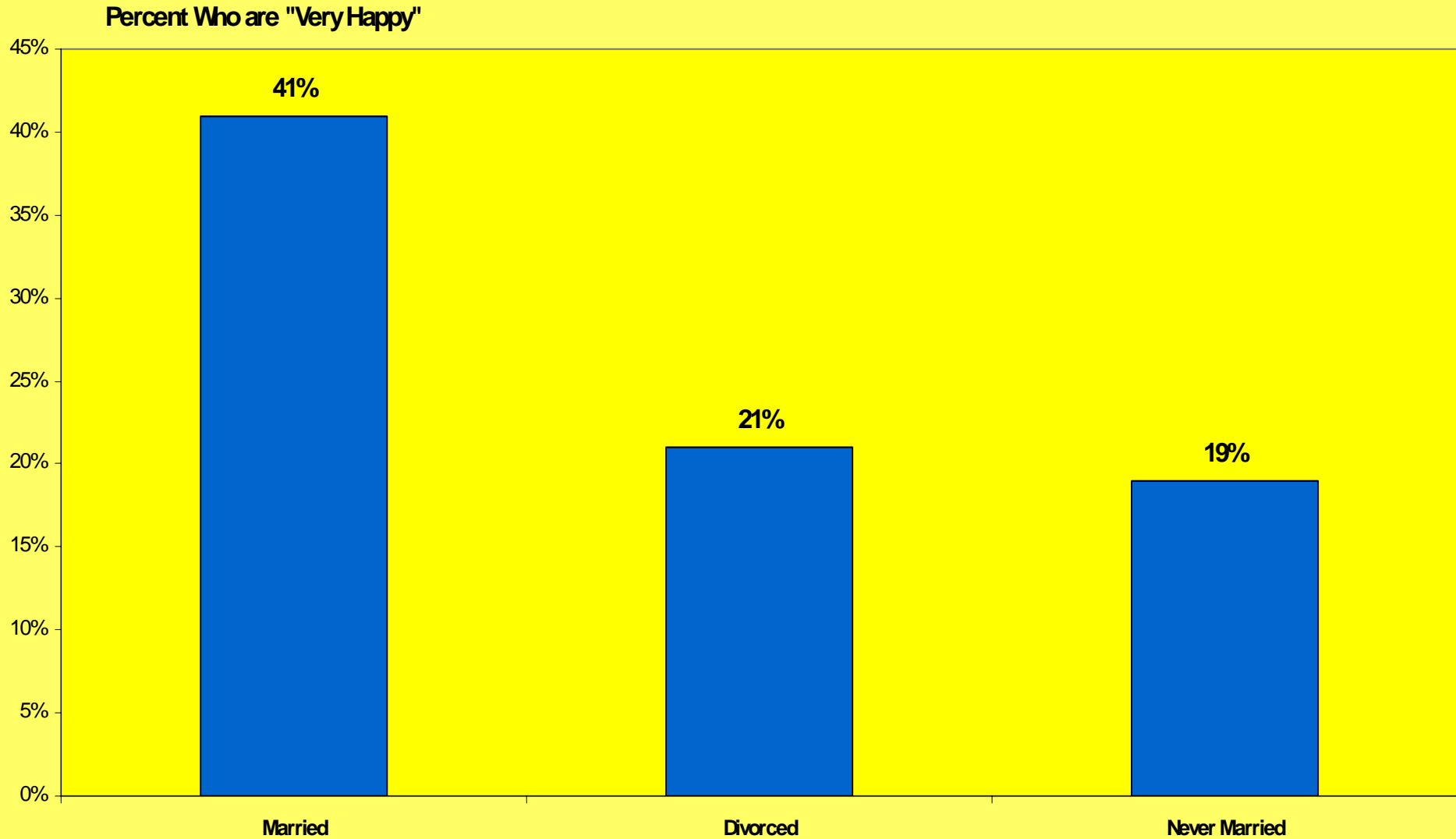
(Chart 4) Impact of Divorce on Income of Families with Children



(Chart 5) Median Net Worth Of Families With Children Under 18, 2000

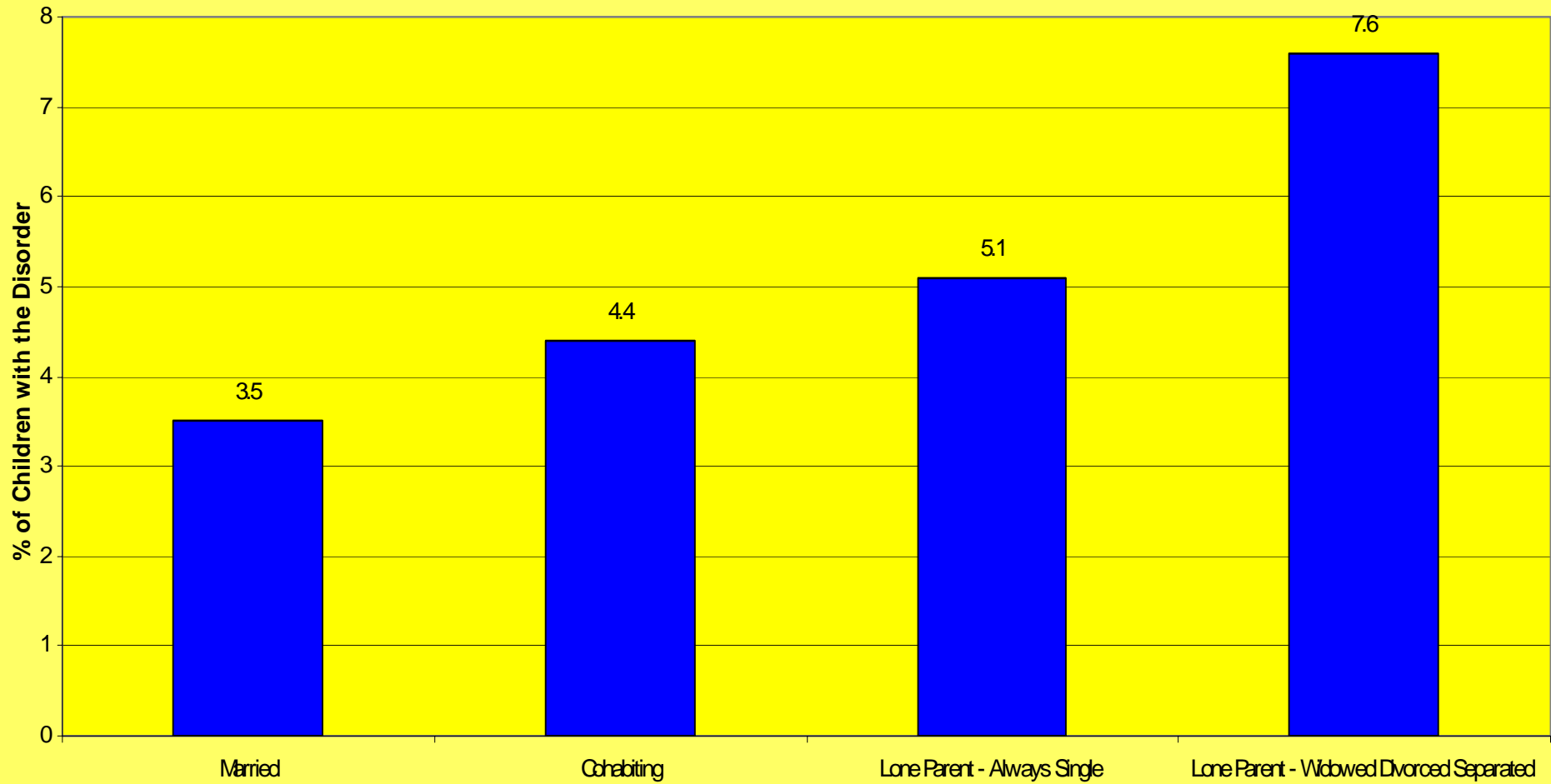


(Chart 6) Married People are More than Twice as Likely to be Happy

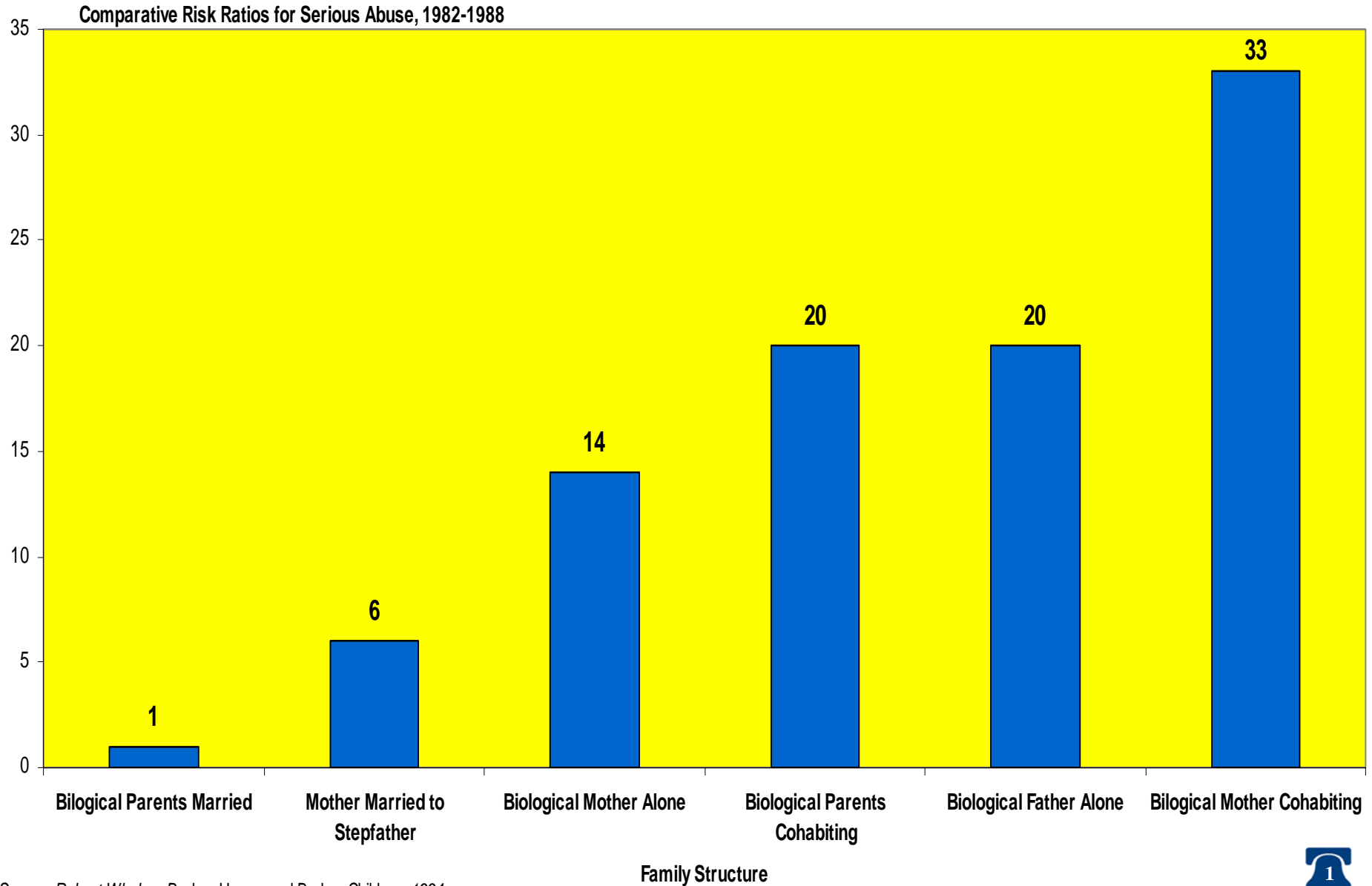

(Chart 7) Emotional Disorders: Children, UK, 1999 by Family Structure



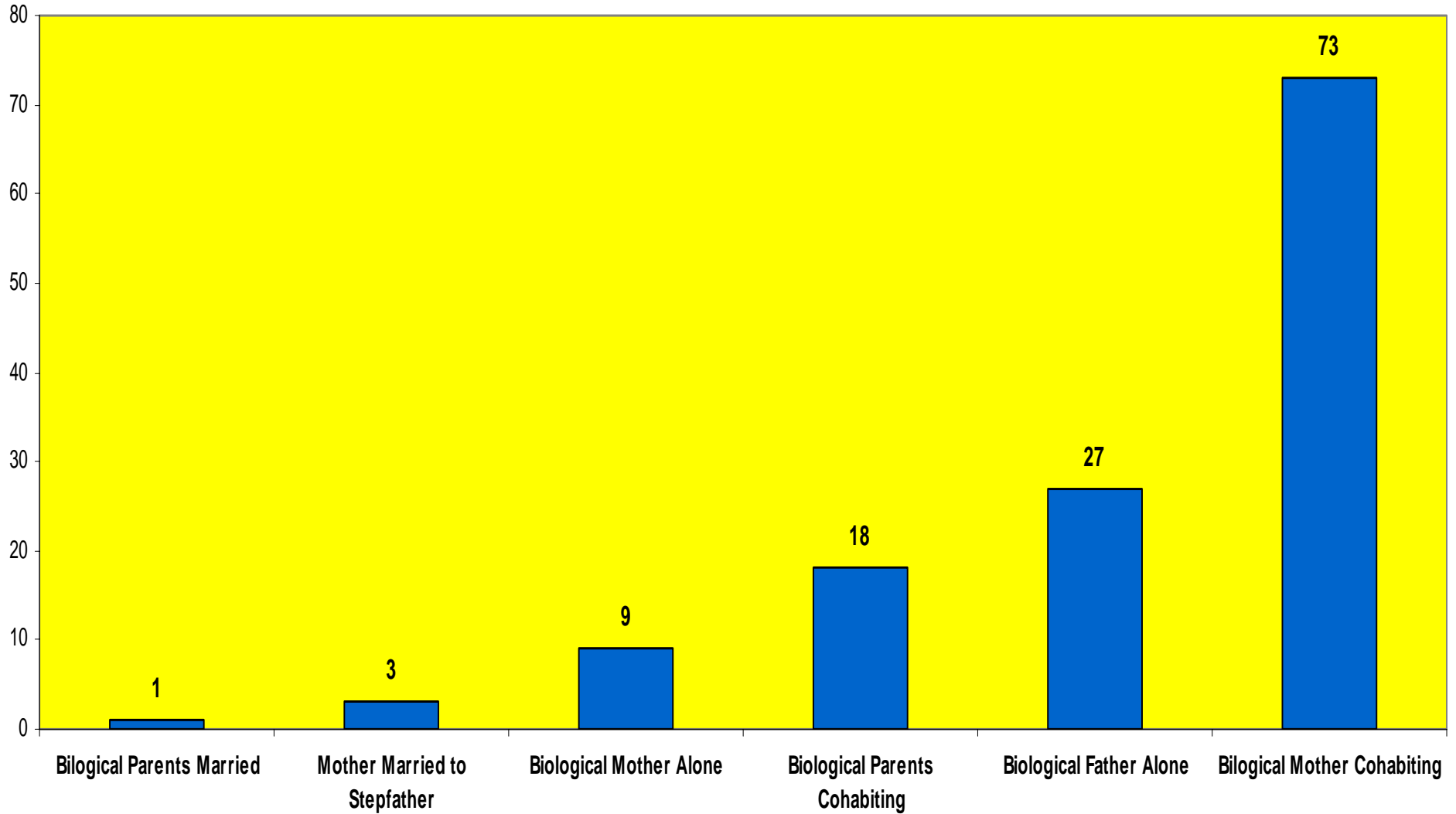
(Chart 8) In Britain, Serious child Abuse

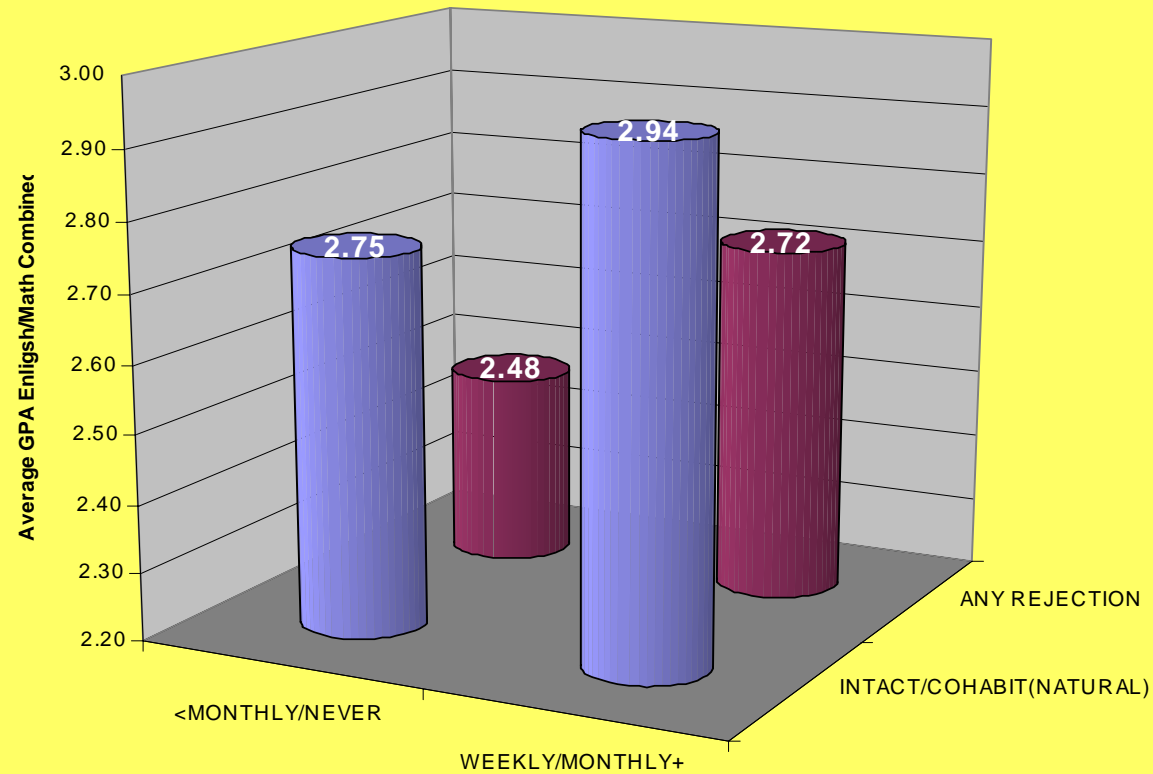
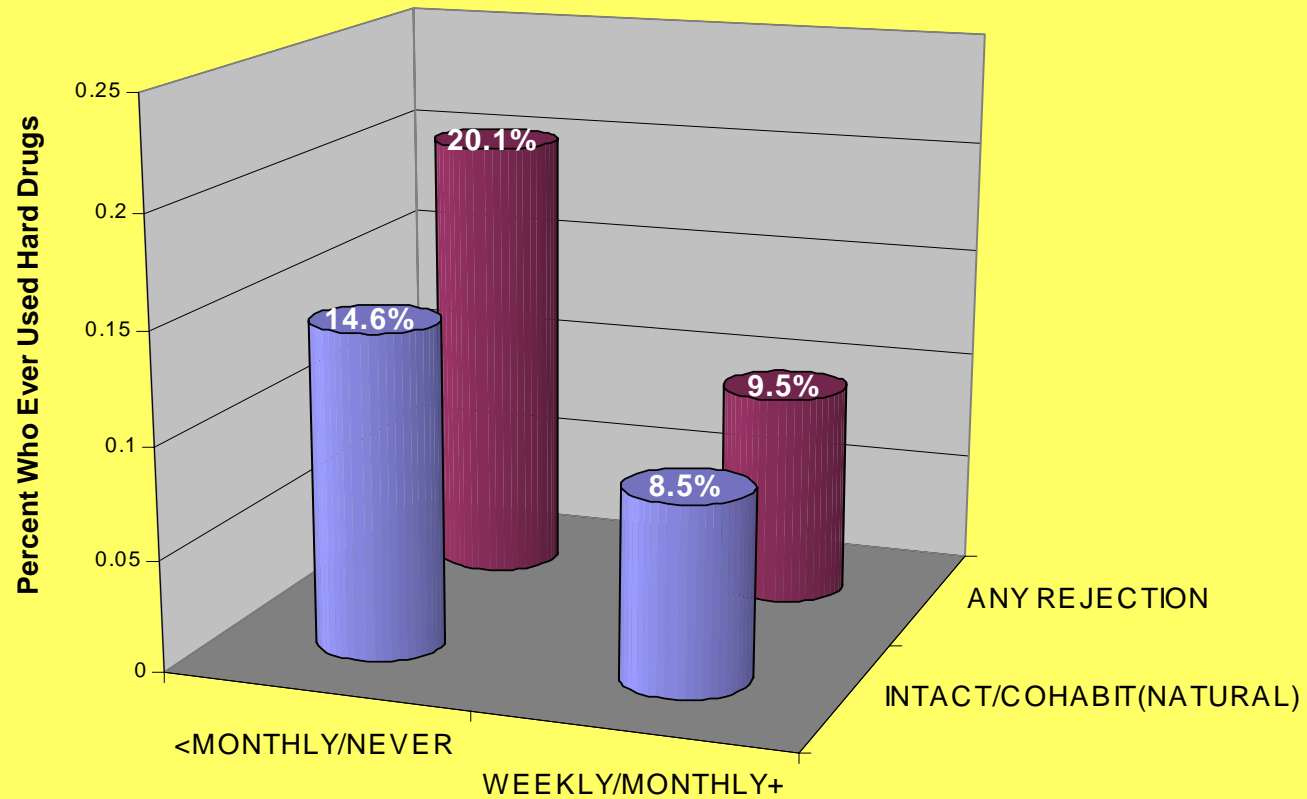


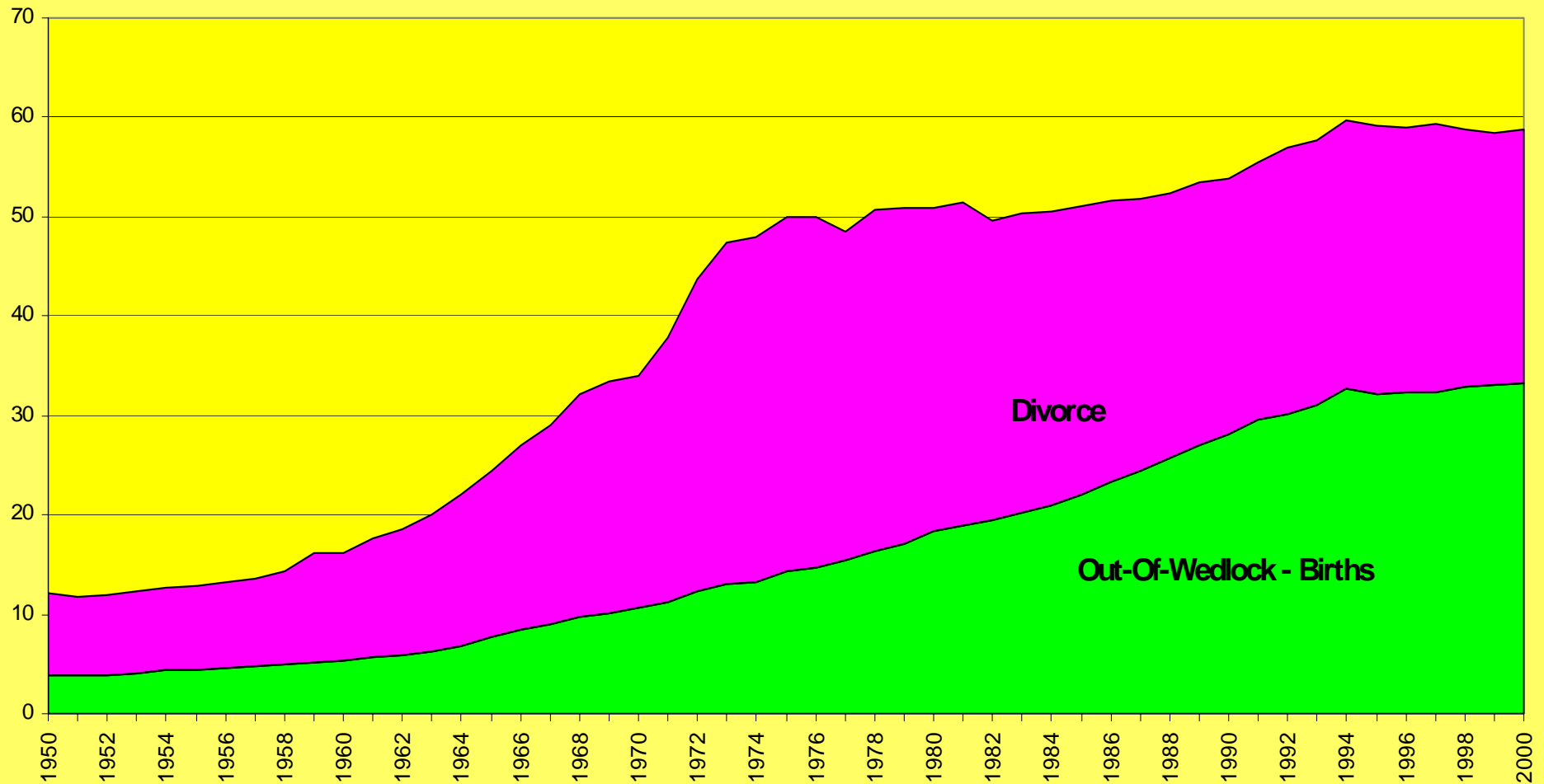
Chart 11 Ever Used Hard Drugs

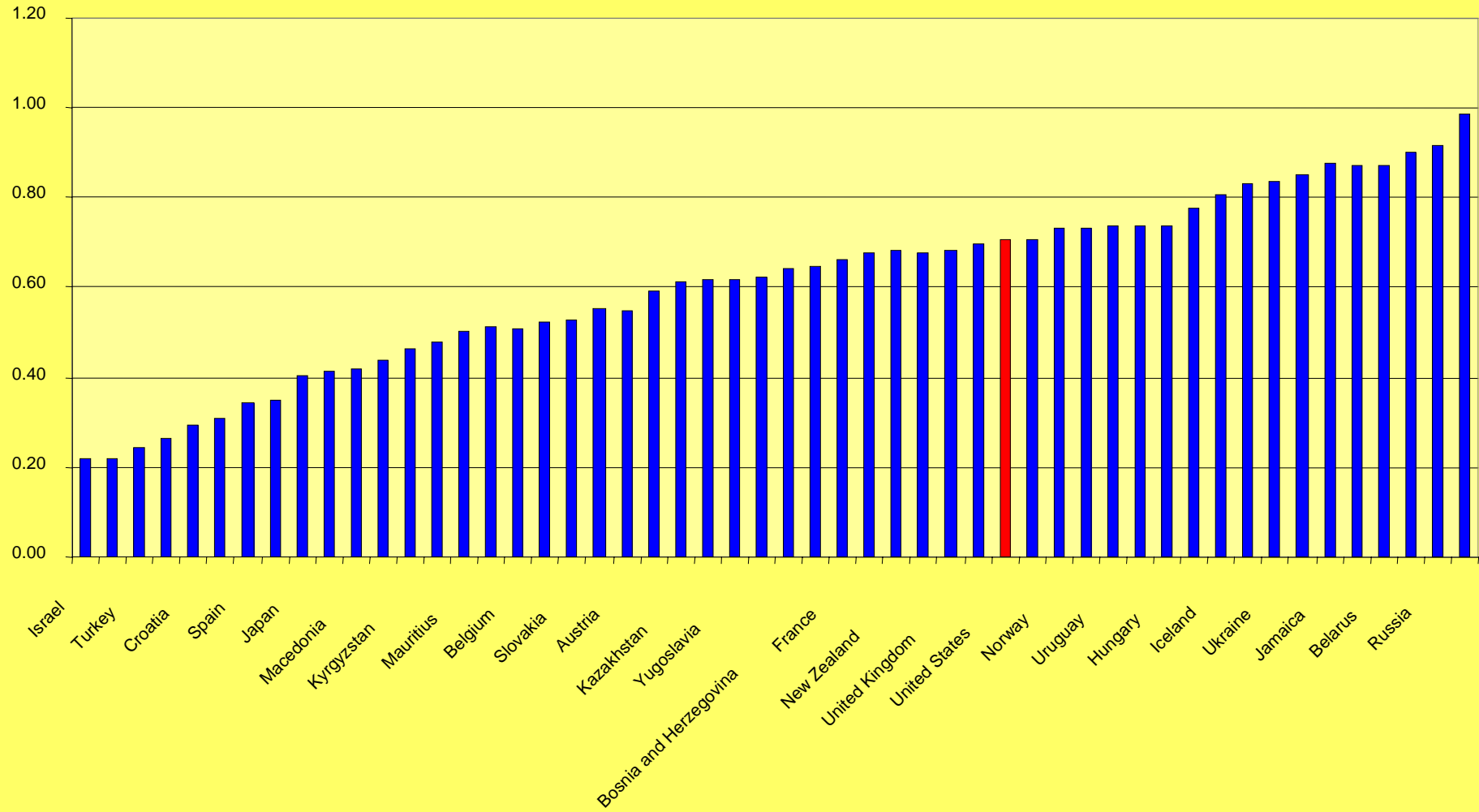


(Chart 12) For Every 100 Children Born: Those Children Experiencing Rejection in Their Family.

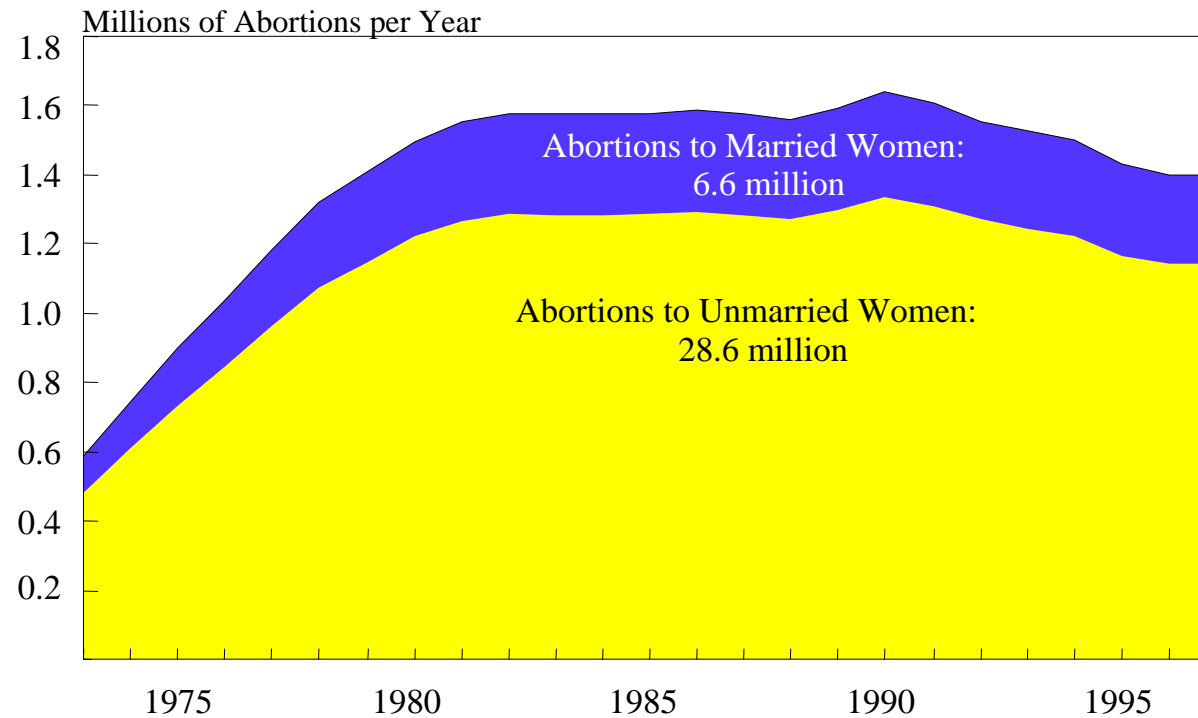

(Chart 13) World Rejection Index 1999

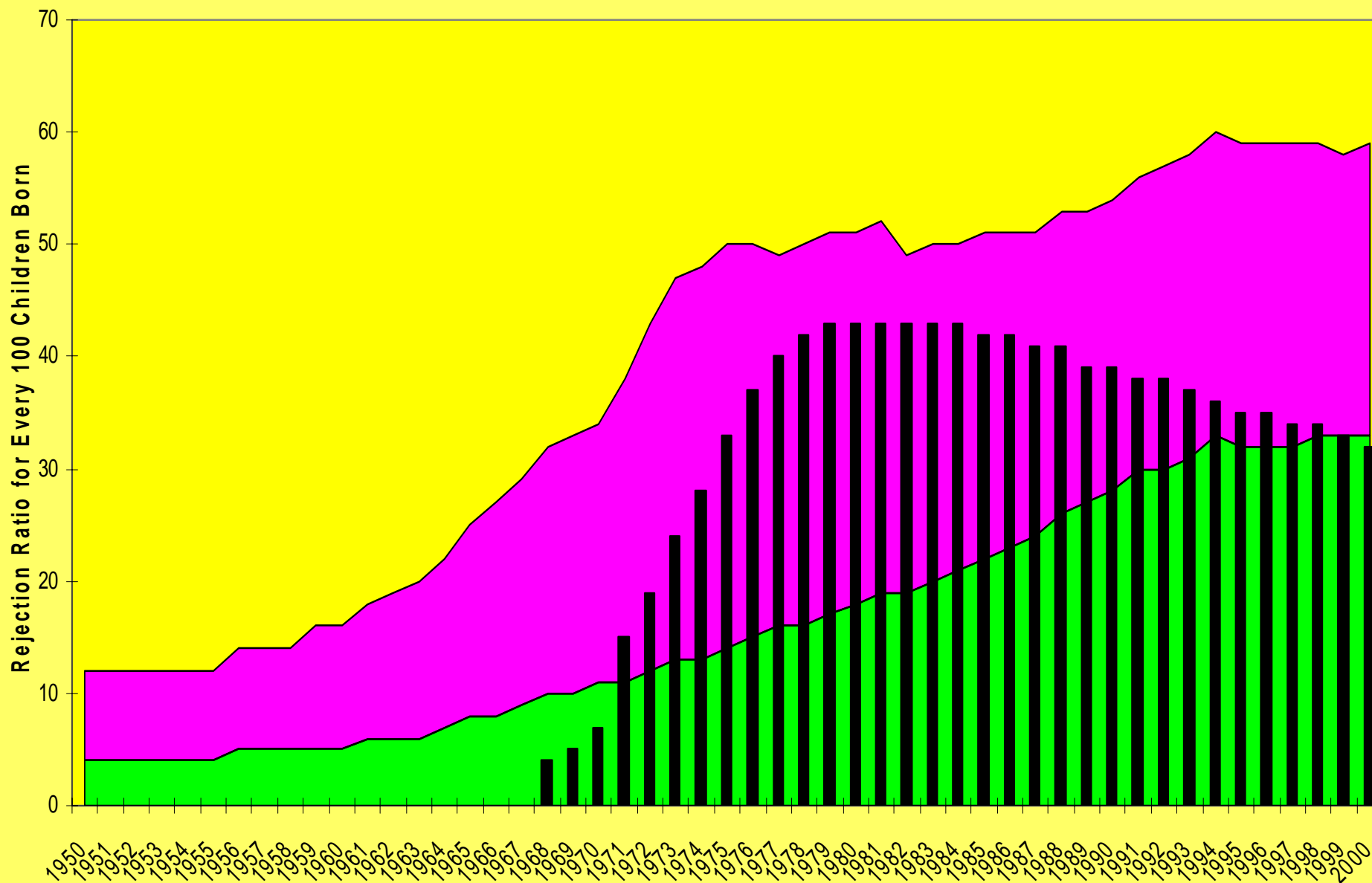


**Chart 14 Estimated Surgical Abortions in the U.S.
by Marital Status, 1972–1997**



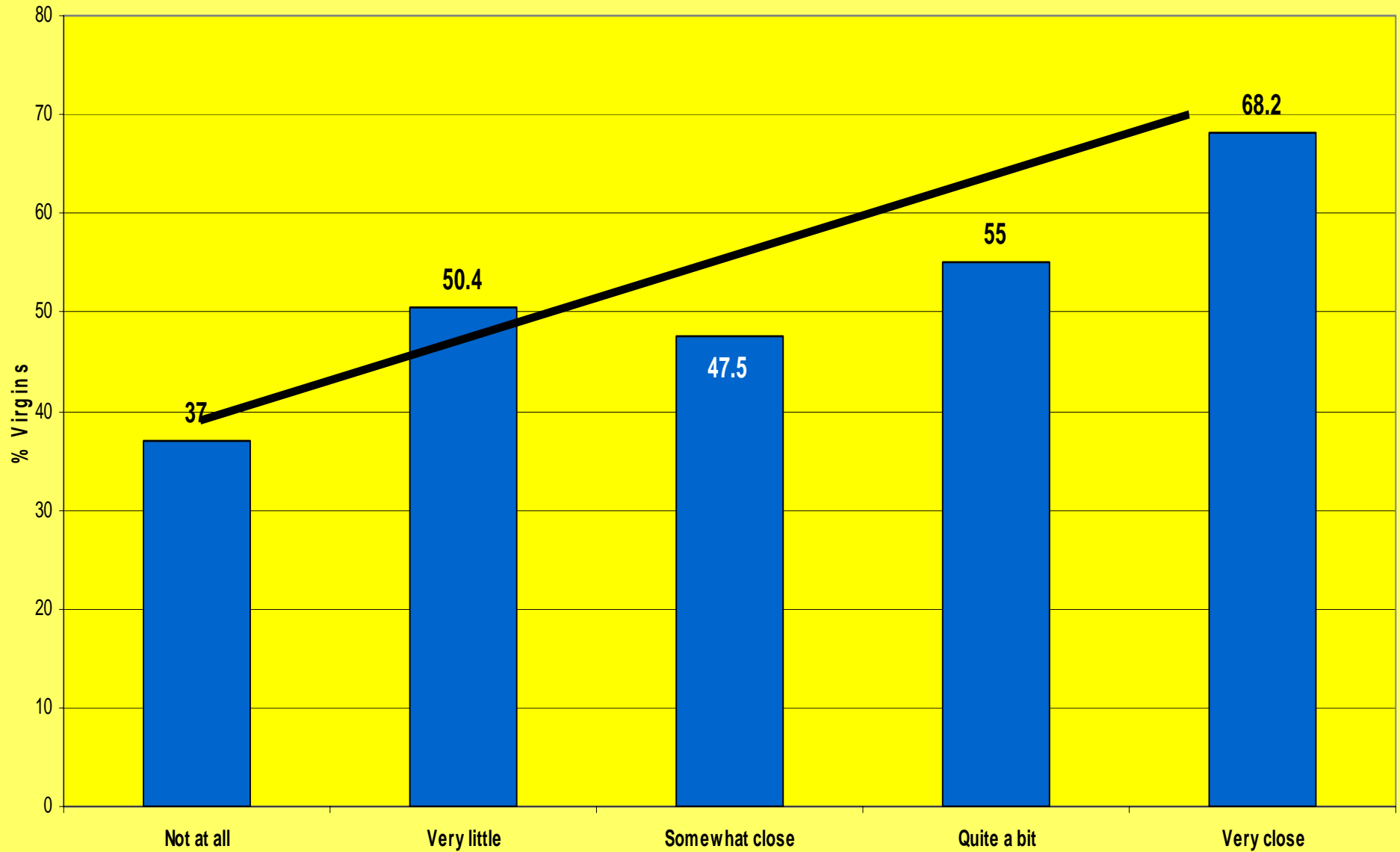

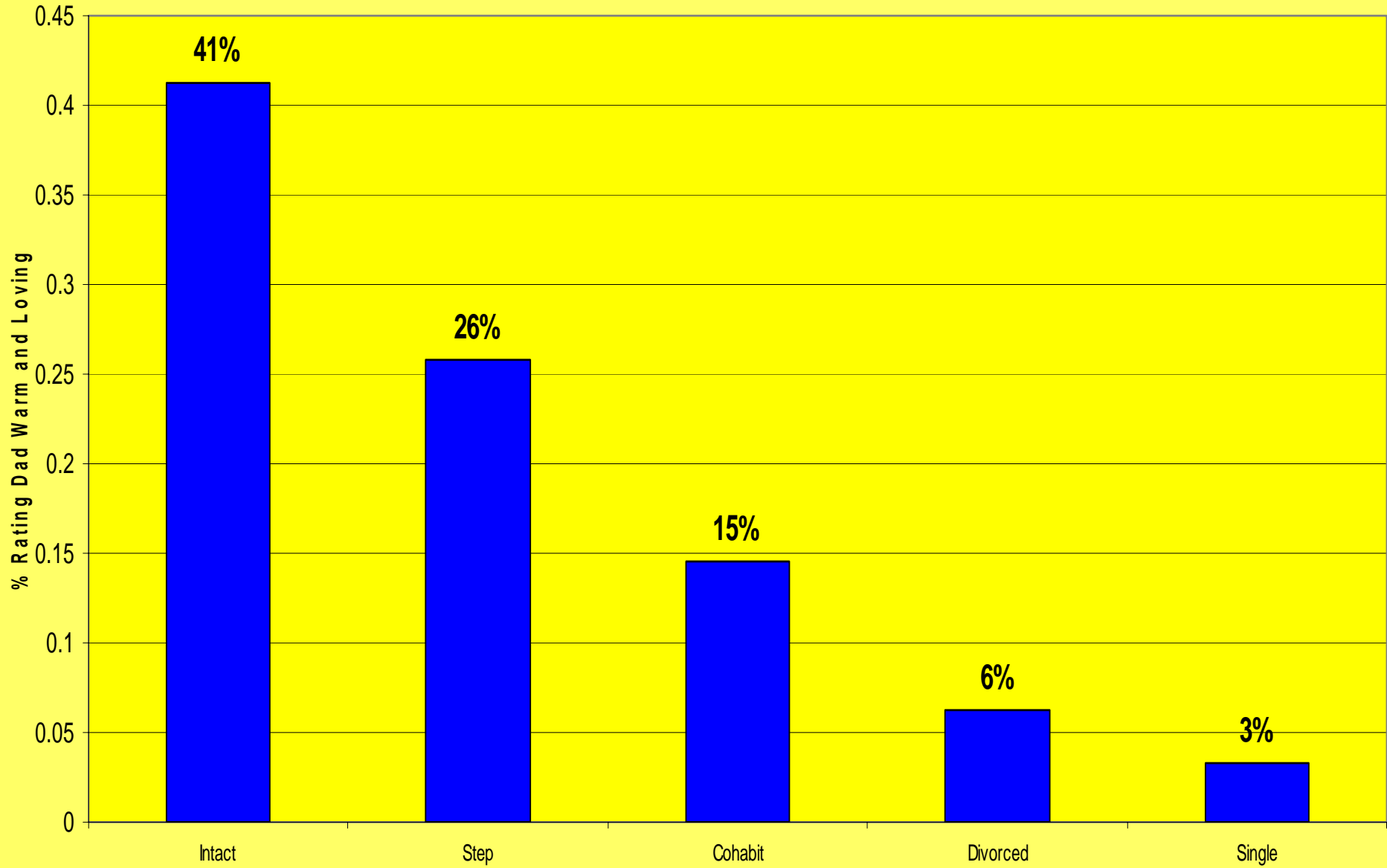
(Chart 16) Teen Feels Father Cares: % who are still virgins

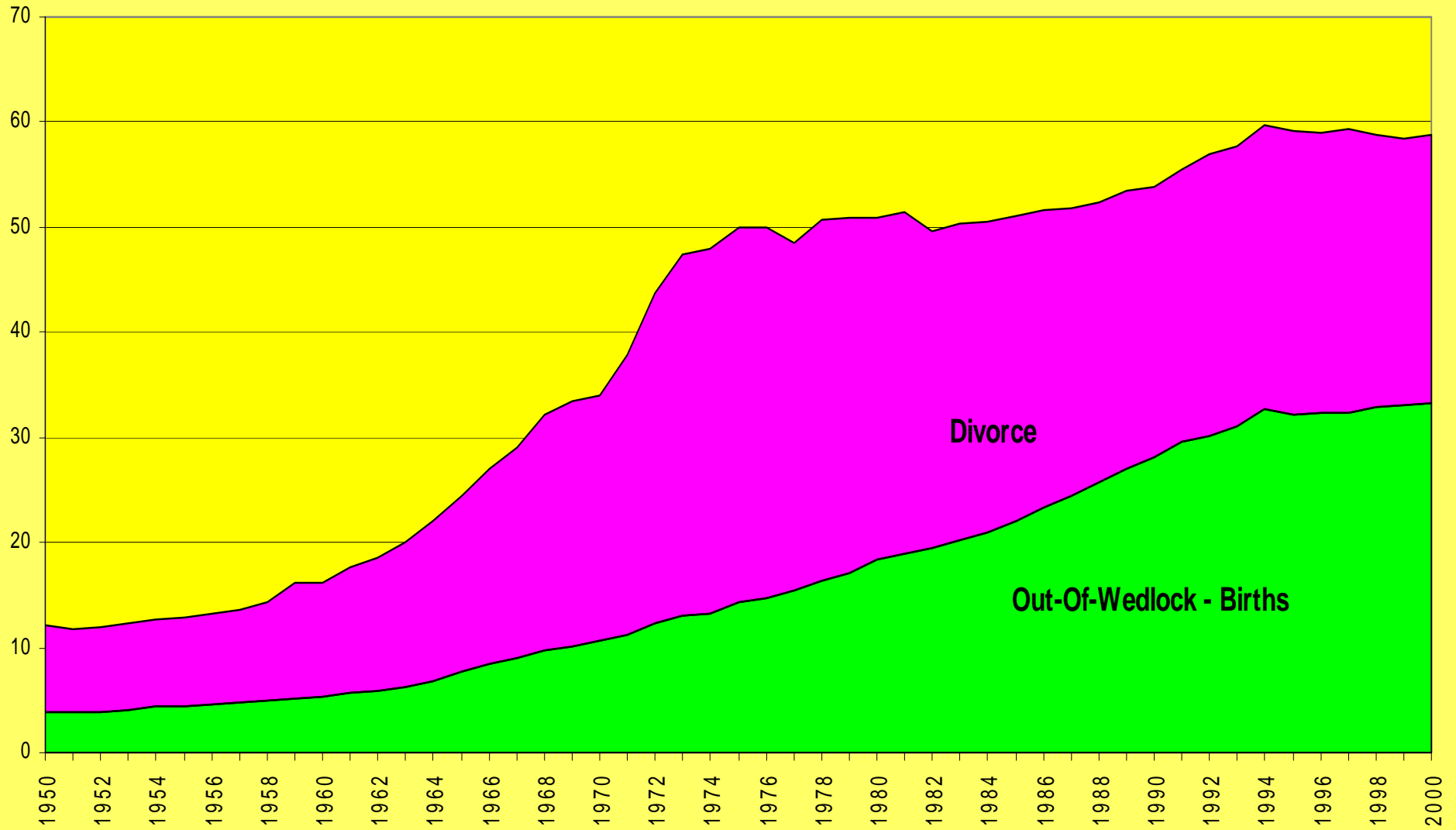


Chart 58 Percent Out-of-Wedlock Births: Europe, 2000

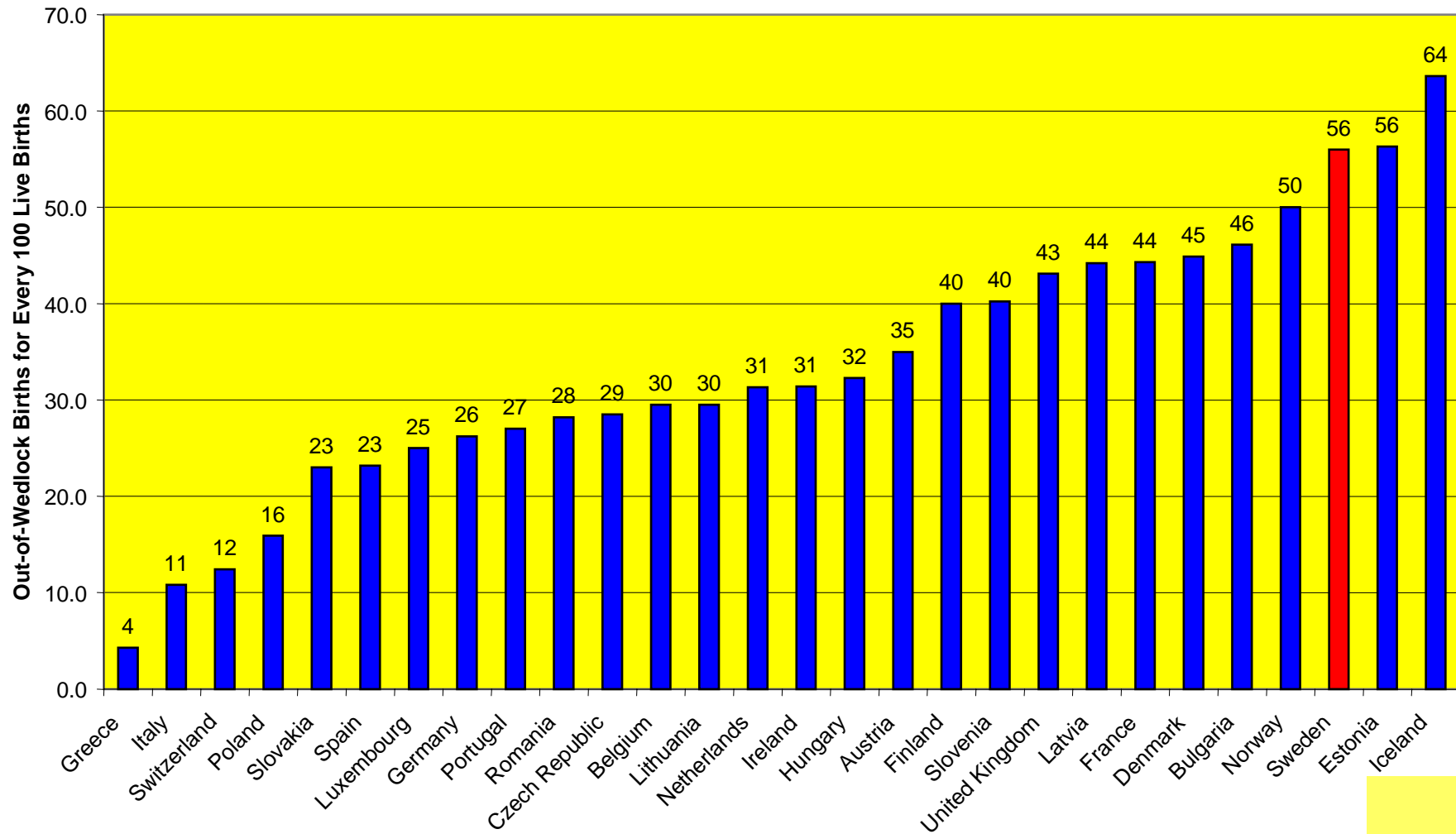


Chart 59 EU: Children/Divorce per 100 Born, 2000

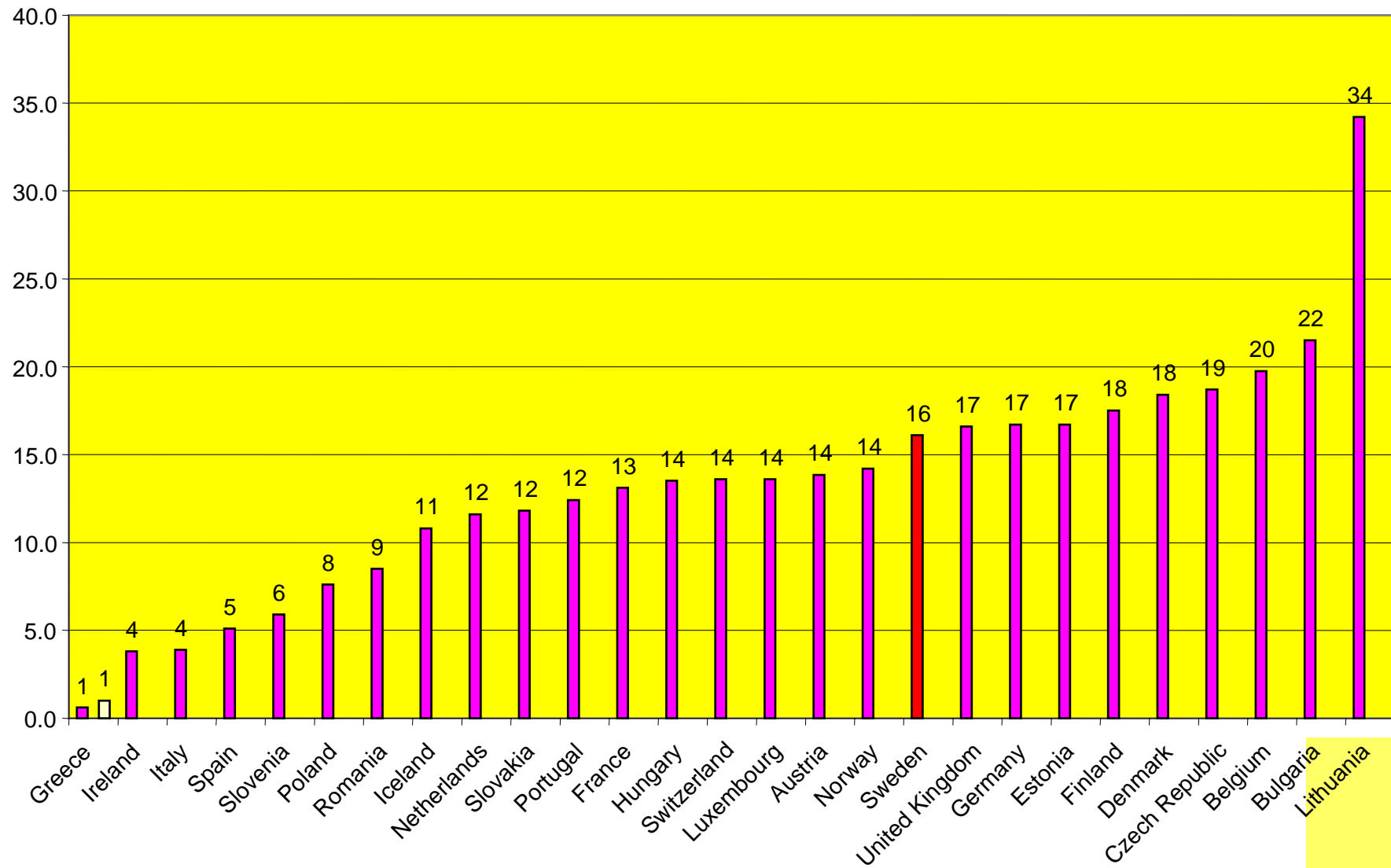


Chart 60 Rejection Ratio EU 2000
